# PLANNED GIVING

It is a common belief that the Church of England is supported as a public service by state funding but this is not the case. Here at St James's we receive no state funding and, therefore, have to raise all the money necessary to support our ministry and running costs.

We are also responsible for the maintenance of our wonderful church building - a Grade One listed Sir Christopher Wren masterpiece. We take our responsibility as custodians of this architectural heritage very seriously, and it makes great demands upon our financial resources.

## Church income

Since we need to generate 100% of our income through our own activities, we aim to make the best use of our site in order to support our work. The income from Piccadilly Market, Caffè Nero, the concert programme, and room hire make a valuable contribution.

However, the donations we receive through Planned Giving are critical to the work of the church - hence this invitation to join our Planned Giving Scheme.

## Expenditure

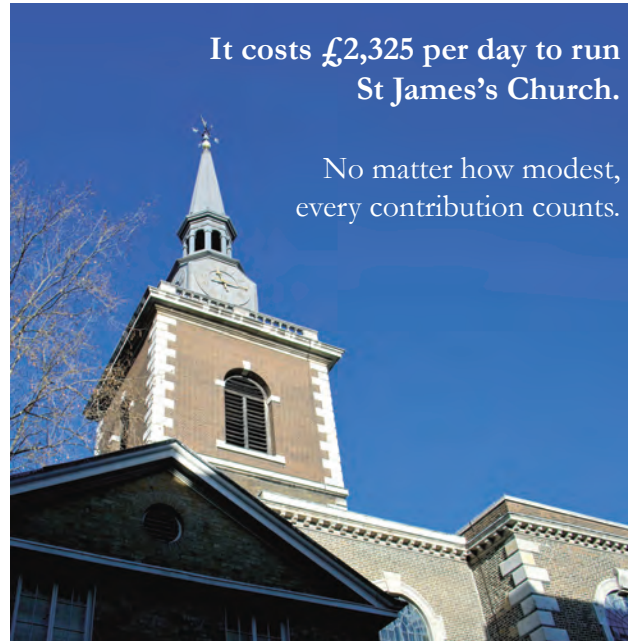
Our annual budget is around £850,000.

This enables us to:

- Run the ministry of the church (including services, other church events and pastoral work).
- To employ a small team of staff to handle administration, finance, concerts, the market, room hire, and site management.
- To maintain all the buildings on our site and keep the church as a welcoming space.

It costs £2,325 per day to run  
St James's Church.
