Sessions start Sunday 6 March and continue for 5 weeks through Lent

Take time in Lent to talk about sharing money, time and gifts, discovering together how we can build a community of love through our many acts of service.

"We first need to know who we are and where we belong. Then, rooted in the deep inner place where we know that we are enough and have enough, we can reach out to live in the discipline of community. We can find a people with whom we can journey. Only then with the support of others, can we actively work to build the community of love in the specific way that is right for us..." Henri Nouwen

In her letter to the congregation written in November last year, The Revd Lucy Winkett wrote:

'If we could summarise what our consultation said, it was 'Be more St James's'. We took that to mean; deepen our prayer and spiritual life, deepen our impact, tell our stories justly and with imagination, stand up for what we believe in, trust in God and in our own capacity for imagining a better future, never let go of our questioning spirit and strong insistence that we know life is messy; and don't be afraid.'

During the past two months, the Giving Team and some congregation members, followed a pilot study using Henri Nouwen's essay 'The Spirituality of Fundraising' (fundraising meaning giving). We started by asking ourselves questions about regular giving and what it means. We found ourselves sharing our life stories, the gospel of our lives, in surprising ways. We created a safe space for these stories and the very different journeys we found ourselves taking.

Now we want to ask you to join us over soup and bread on Sundays in Lent, to look at this together. We are looking through the lens of giving, not only money, but time and also sharing other gifts, and our presence alongside each other, to build a community of belonging and to ask how we can be an integral part of bringing our vision to life.

This is an invitation is to come and see. We recognise the last two years have left many exhausted, so come as you are, connect, reconnect, talk, listen, and be.

Structure & Content

There will a simple meal of bread and soup served when the Sunday service finishes.

12.45pm: Start

Each week will begin with prayer and the chance to say hello to your neighbours.

1pm: Introduction

Introduce session and break into smaller groups to reflect and share.

1.45pm: Reconvene

Regather with one reflection back from each group with a note for questions & actions.

2pm: Close with prayer

There will be a Lent resource pack with the topics & suggested questions/reflections for each week. we'll try to make the groups the same each week, but come and join whenever you can, there's always room.
