Funerals & Memorials

We know arranging a funeral or memorial service can be an overwhelming time. Our experience means that we are able to walk alongside you, your family and friends to help you say goodbye in a way that feels right to you.

Our Christian faith tells us that 'love is stronger than death' and that there is more beyond this present time and earthly reality. We hold on to this, amid the sadness and sorrow, and stand with you as we shape the service together. Our aim is to listen and ensure that we are able to do as much as we can to accommodate your wishes for the day.

We want to get it right for you and we want the day to be memorable and special. We will take the time to be with you and offer pastoral care and support. St James's will be there to place the memories of your loved one within a dignified and beautiful service.

Each year we also hold a Requiem Eucharist for All Souls' Day in November. We invite relatives that have lost someone in the past year to attend and light a candle in their memory, and we read out the names of those that have died.



Arrangements

We offer funeral and memorial services to anyone with a connection to St James's Church or the local area. Funeral services are often planned in the week or two following the death of a loved one.

Once a date has been agreed then a member of clergy will meet with the next of kin, and thereafter progress your plans as swiftly and smoothly as possible, in close communication with your chosen funeral directors.

Memorial services generally take place about a year after a funeral, though this varies widely.

Once a date has been agreed, a member of the clergy will meet with nominated family and friends at least once, and thereafter the clergy, Parish Administrator and our Director of Music will help you craft a fitting service to celebrate the life of your loved one.

Music fees

St James's is renowned for the quality of its music. All genres of music can be arranged, ranging from solo classical instrumentalists and vocalists to ensembles and choirs.

Church fees

The fee for a memorial service is £1,500, made up of a number of elements including officiant, verger and facility fee.

The fee for a funeral is £431 (amended annually). This is made up of a number of elements including the service, verger and facility fee.

A deposit of £100 is payable

in order for a special service to be booked in the church diary on a given date.
