Daniel Piers is a British-Spanish jazz pianist based in London. He taught himself jazz piano in his late teenage years after falling in love with the music of Erroll Garner and Oscar Peterson. Having established firm roots in the swing tradition, he began to experiment with more contemporary sounds - absorbing the music of John Taylor, Gonzalo Rubalcaba and Shai Maestro. Under the guidance of renowned British pianist Julian Joseph, Daniel has been cultivating a deep rhythmic approach and melodic sensibility to improvised music. He was one of the few selected to compete in the 15th Unisa International Jazz Piano Competition which will take place in January 2024 in Pretoria, South Africa. With a unique voice as a composer, Daniel seeks to explore the connections between different genres of music from around the globe and highlight the universality of music.
