BIOGRAPHIES

Dorian Rambaud began violin studies at the Academy of Music of Vence.

After 5 years in the Conservatoire National Supérieur de Musique de Paris, he obtained his prize with unanimous high honors in 2022.

He played in a lot of chamber music festivals including appearances at the Philharmonie de Paris.

He received many advices from prestigious musicians as Christophe Collette, Gunter Pichler and Jean Mouillère.

As a soloist, he performed with the orchestre of the Syrinx concerts, alongside Gilles Apap, the Orchestre Symphonique Azuréen and with the Orchestre National of Cannes.

Prize-winner at the international violin competition of Cambrai and the Grand Prix du Rotary Paris-Normandie, he also was rewarded by the prize of the strongest artistic personality at the Lipizer international violin competition.

He's currently following an Artist Diploma programme at the Royal College of Music, as a RCM Scholar, with Emily Sun.
