Trio Allegria is a London based Flute trio, established recently in their fourth year at the Royal Academy of Music formed of flute (Alexia Pasquariello), violin (Qicong Lou), and viola (Beatrice Slocumbe). Highlighted in their name Allegria, the ensemble has never had a rehearsal without laughter especially when tackling fast passages in Beethoven's Serenade. Individually they have experience of working with orchestras such as the Shanghai Philharmonic Orchestra, Burcharest Symphony Orchestra and Chineke! Orchestra in venues such as Cadogan Hall, Royal Festival Hall and the Queen Elizabeth Hall.

The trio values how connecting music can be as they feel united in their joy for chamber music despite each member coming from different parts of the world. The unique combination of instruments makes it even more exciting for the trio to discover new colours, characters and articulations in their sound while introducing new ways to blend their contrasting timbres together.
